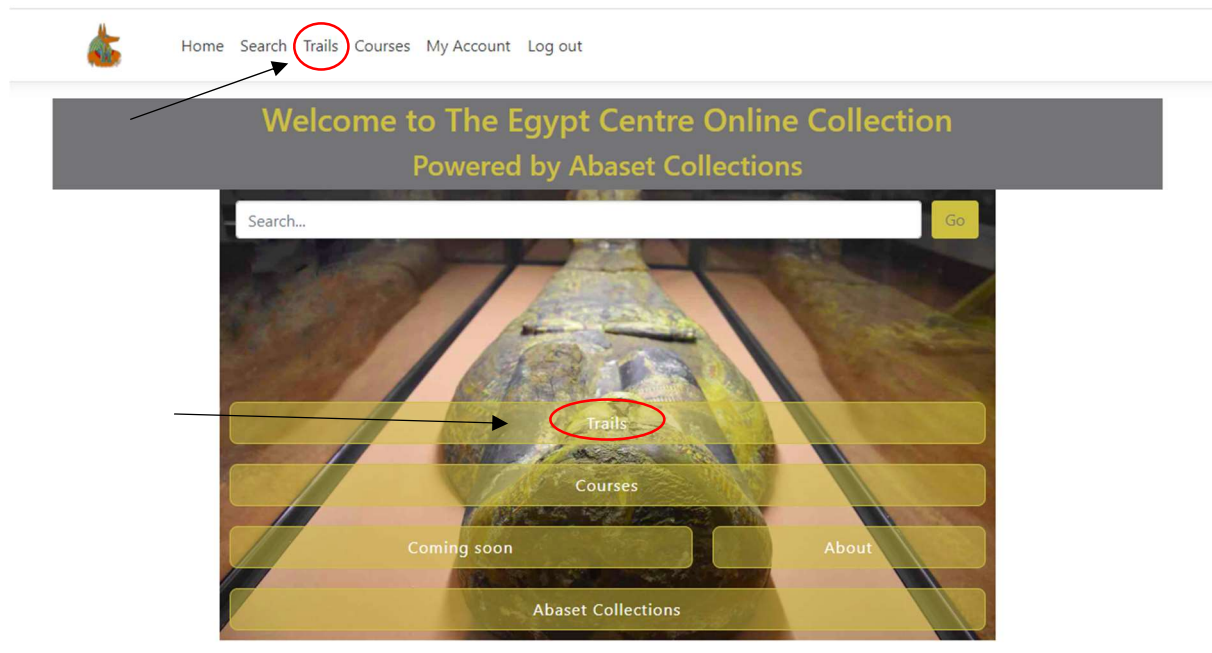


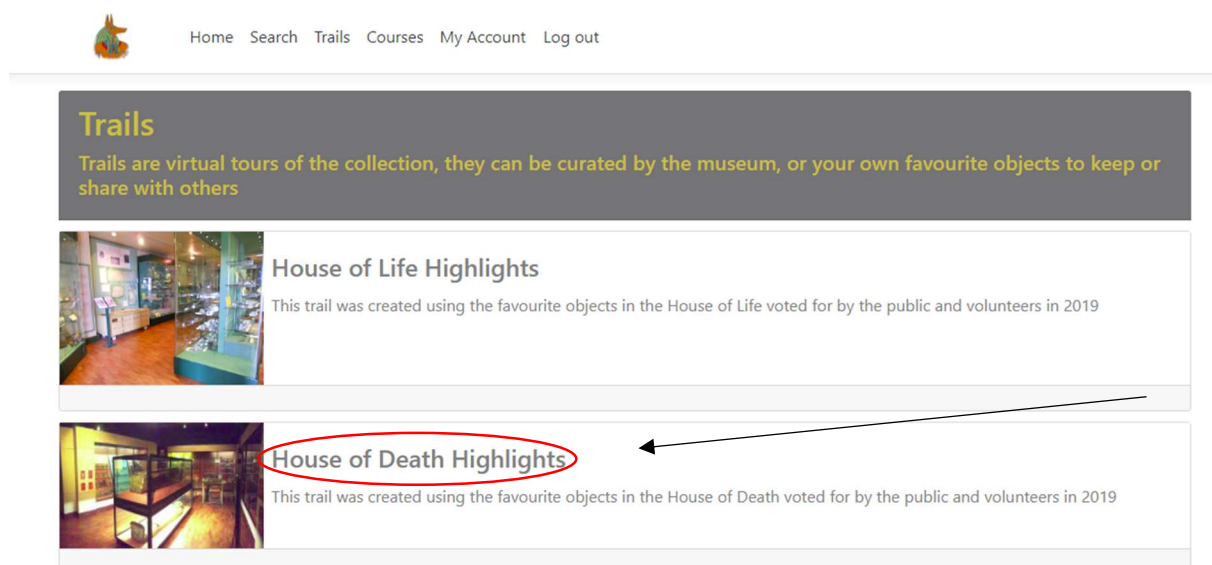
A guide to viewing trails in the Egypt Centre Online Collection

Trails are a selection of objects that you can view, which have been grouped together by the Egypt Centre for you to enjoy. You can view the trails on either a laptop or mobile. This means you can learn more about these objects from the comfort of your own home, on the go, or even whilst in the galleries.

1. From the home page, select the trails tab, found at the top of the screen, or in the central options.



2. You will then see a list of available trails to view. Click on the trail you would like to follow. For this example, I will select the House of Death Highlights.



- Now I can view the objects in the trail. This page will display the objects in a single column if viewing on a mobile, or will appear in a grid if viewing on a laptop. In this view you can see the individual objects within a trail. Where available, the audio description of the object will display—you can click on the play button to listen to these as you would in any media player. Beneath this is a comment from the author of the trail. I can click on the object to find out more about it.
