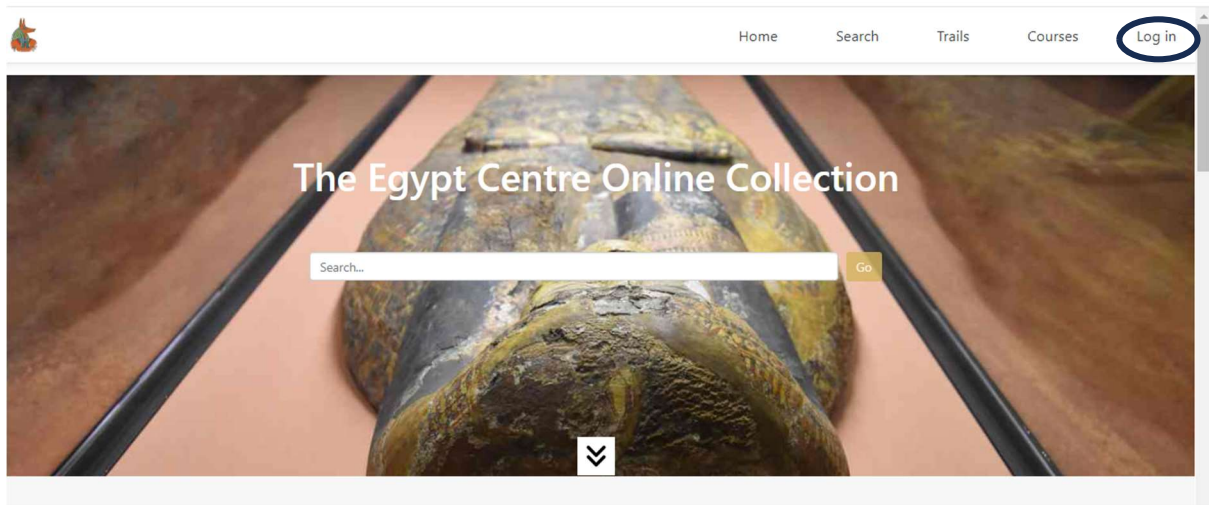



How to create your own trail on Abaset.

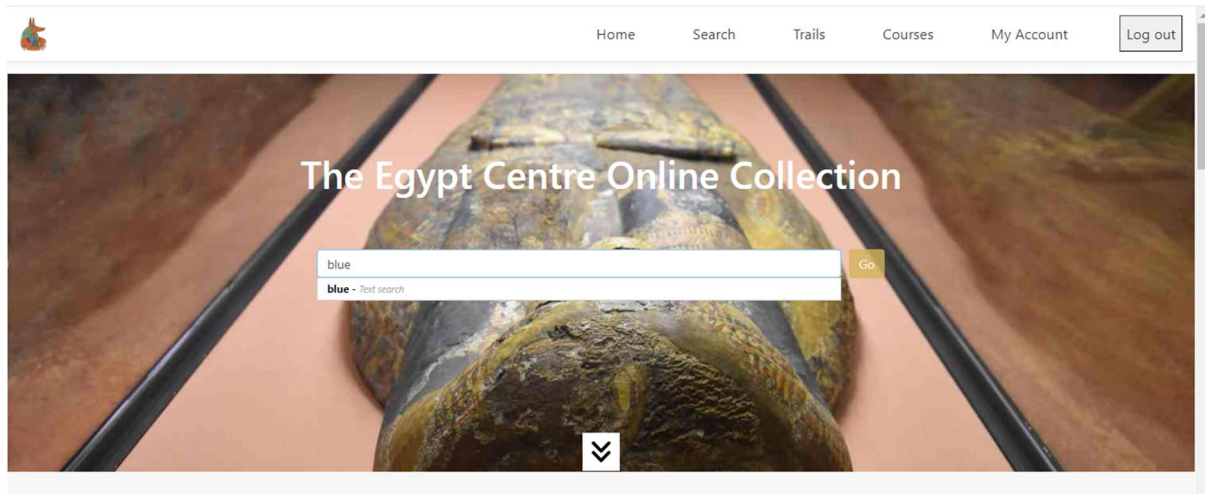
1. Firstly, you need to log in by clicking on 'log in' in the top right corner of the home screen.



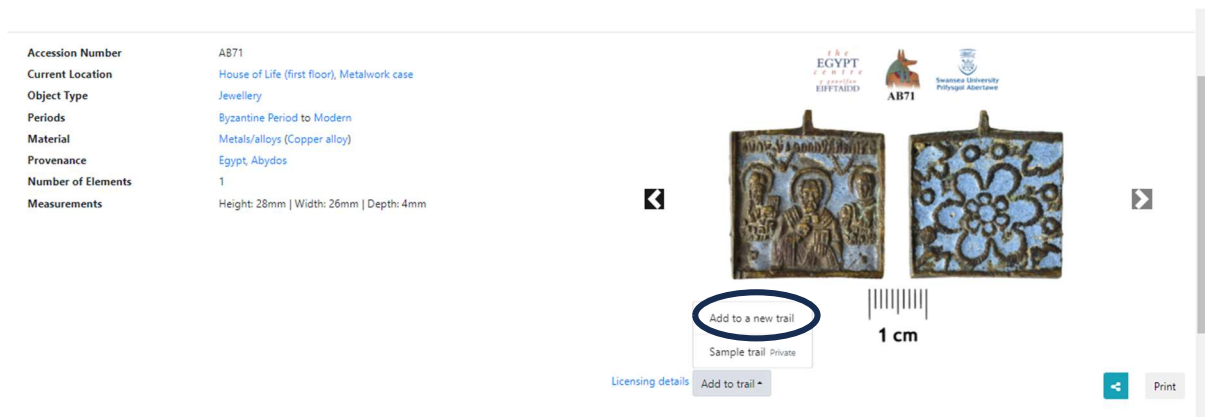
2. If you haven't logged in before, you will first need to register as a new user (by clicking 'register as new user'). Alternatively, you will need to enter your email and password and hit 'enter'.

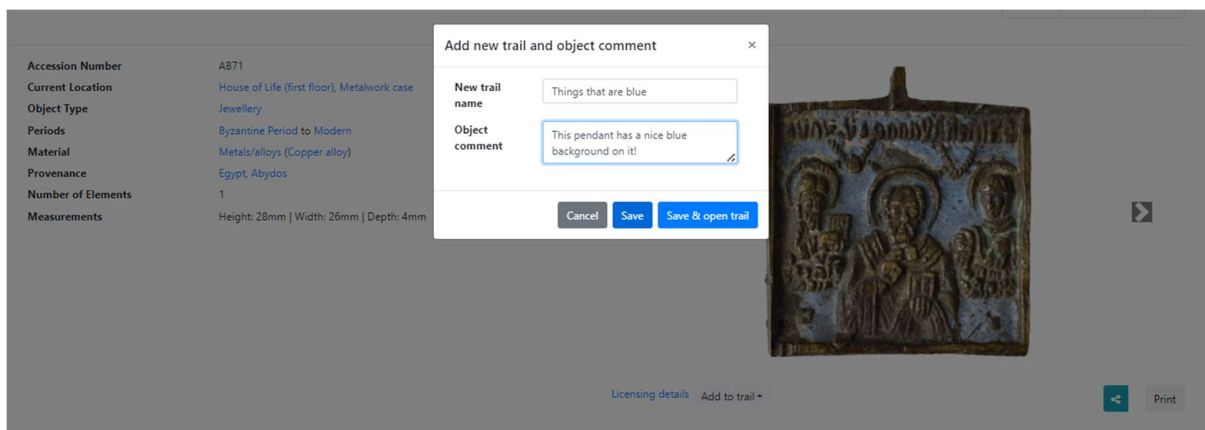
- Once you have logged in, choose the first object you would like to include in your trail. For this example, I am creating a trail of things that are blue, and so I am searching 'blue' in the search bar for inspiration, but if you have a specific object in mind, you can head straight there!



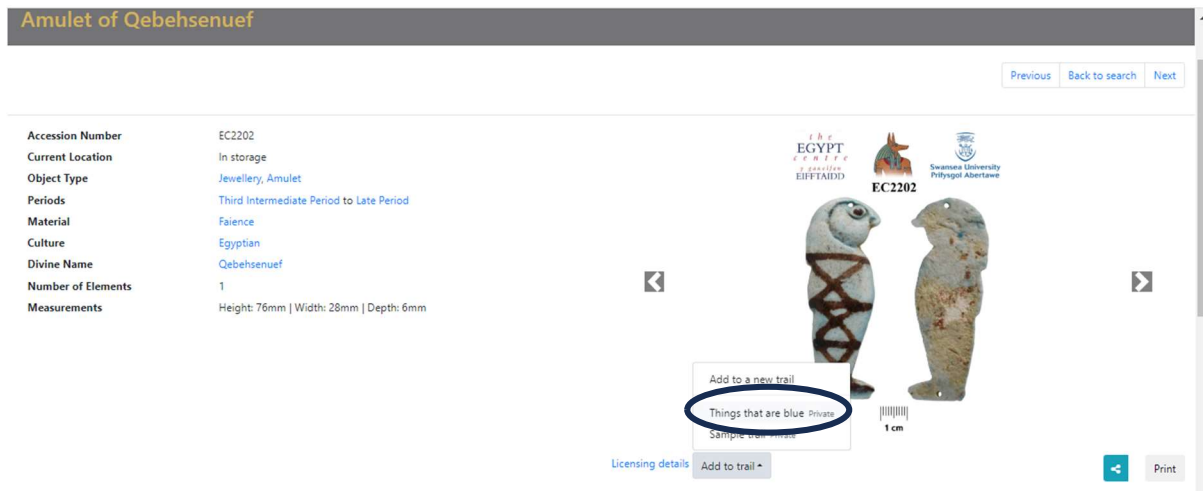
- I've chosen this Coptic pendant as my first object, so I need to hit "add to trail" which can be found just beneath the image of the object, and select 'add to a new trail'.



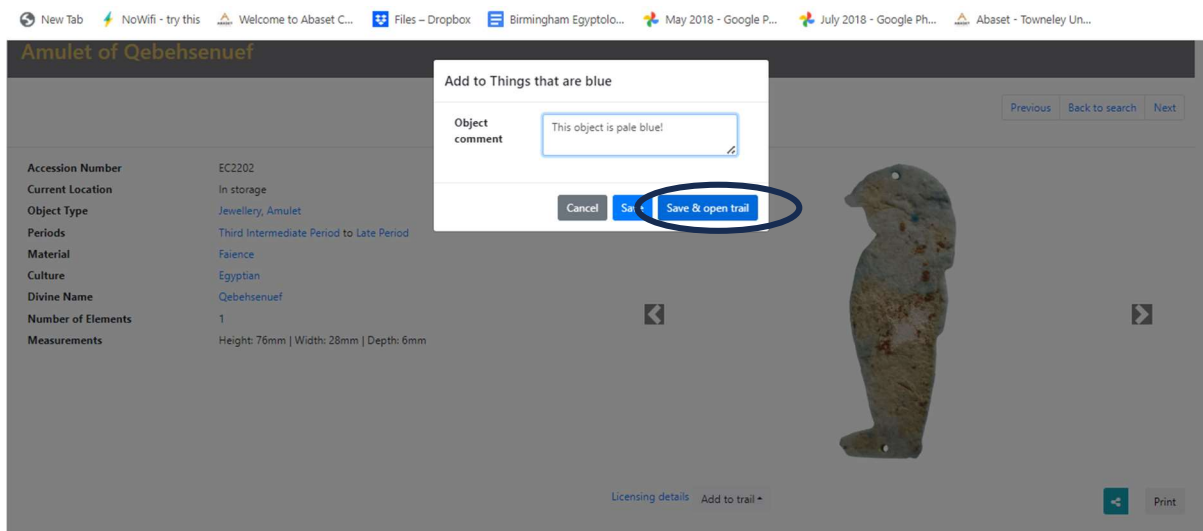
- A pop up window will appear asking for the name of the trail and the option to write an option description to add to the object within the trail. You can click save and choose your next object.



- The next object I want to add is this amulet, so I again click on 'add to trail' beneath the image. This time, my trail name 'Things that are blue' already exists so I can click it to add this object to my existing trail.



- You can continue to add items, or, after writing my description, I will select 'save & open trail' to see how my trail is looking.



8. On this edit page, you can add a description of your trail, select if you want your trail to be private or publicly accessible (so if you share the hyperlink others can see it), reorder your objects, or edit your descriptions.



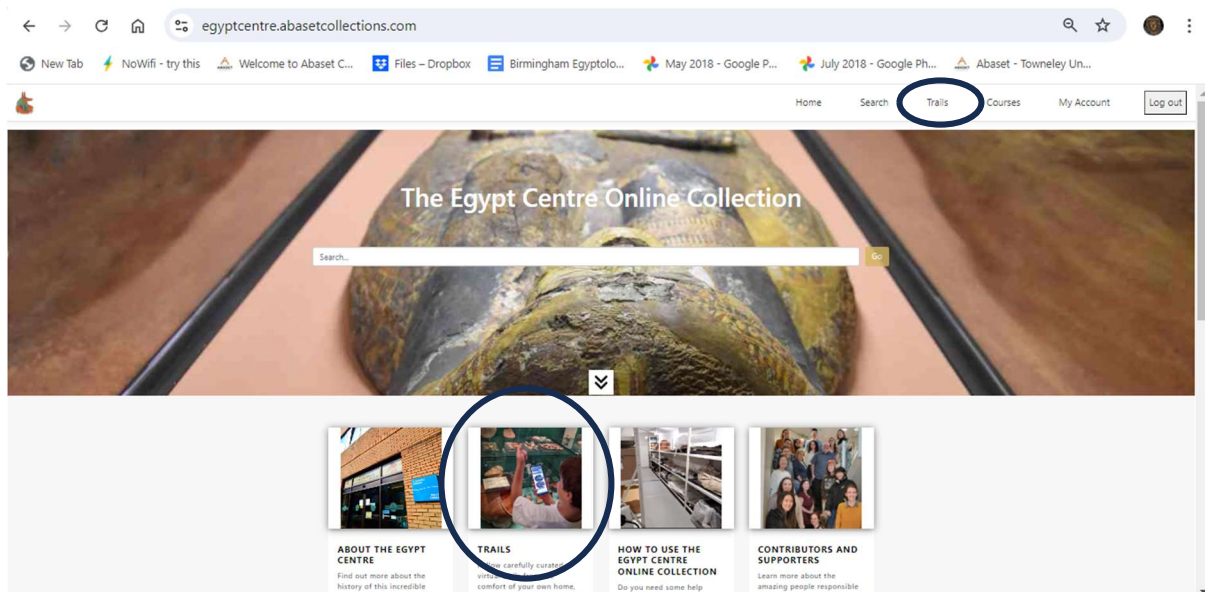

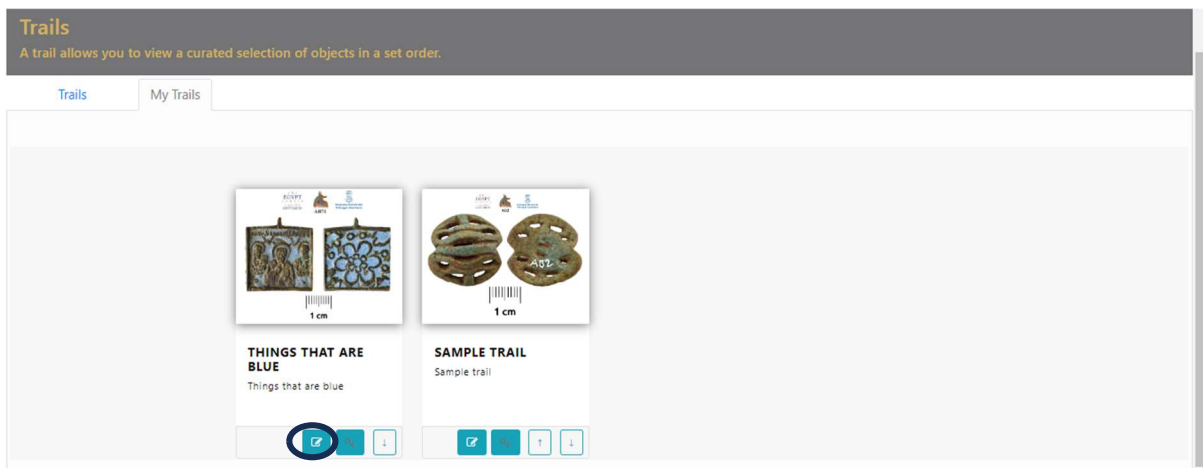
9. If you want to come back to your trails in the future, you can find them under the trails tab at the top of the screen, or the tile at the bottom of the homepage.
